

# Summer Study Abroad in Ireland

June 4 - June 25, 2019

Spend three weeks in summer 2019 in Ireland, earning six transferable credit hours in Irish Literature and Irish Culture.

As part of this study abroad program you will visit various areas:

- Overnight trip to Belfast City and the northern coast, West Belfast, Giant's Causeway, Bushmills Distillery, Carrick-a-Rede Rope Bridge.
- County Carlow various areas
- Kilkenny—Kilkenny Castle, St. Francis Brewery
- Dublin City, various sites including Book of Kells at Trinity College
- County Wicklow—made famous in several movies including P.S. I Love You and Braveheart.
- Glendalough—early medieval settlement.

Your home base is Carlow College, the 2nd oldest college in Ireland. Located in Carlow, Ireland, the quintessential Irish country town in southeastern Ireland. Dublin is only about an hour away and is easily accessible by both train and bus.

The cost of transportation and entry fees for all cultural excursions are included in the program cost. The cost for summer 2019 is \$3,850.
